#### **About this survey**

#### **About our plan**

We are the City of York Council. We run lots of services for people in our area.



One of the services we run is **social care**. **Social care** is care and support people might need at home, in their local community or in a care home.



When people aged 18 and older need support from us, we call it **adult social** care.



Adult social care gives people the help they need to live the life they want.



We have written a new plan about adult social care in York.



It says how we will give people good advice, care and support.



We are asking lots of people what they think about our plan.



We have some questions for you to answer.

#### **Our Privacy notice**



Before you answer our questions, you need to read our **privacy notice**.

It tells you how we will use and look after the information you tell us on the form.



The law says organisations must have a privacy notice.



It is up to you if you want to take part in the survey.

You do not have to take part if you do not want to.



If you take part, you do not have to answer all of the questions.

### How we will use your information



We can only use the things you tell us if you agree. This is called **giving** consent.



We will use what people tell us to write a report.



If we write what you tell us in the report, we will not put things like your name or address in it.



That way nobody can tell it was you who told us.



### How we look after your information

We will keep your information locked up safely on our computers.



We will only share your information with other organisations:

If the law says we need to share it



or

 To stop someone from getting hurt.



We will only keep your information for as long as we need it. Then we will delete it.



#### **Your rights**

Your **rights** are things you are allowed to do and how you should be treated.



The law says you have rights when we keep information about you.






