Local Plan Publication Consultation commences on 21st February and ends on 4th April 2018.

The Local Plan sets out the planning vision for the City of York until 2030. It sets out a vision, strategic objectives, targets; policies and proposals that ensure the protection and enhancement of the City's historical and green assets whilst ensuring that carefully designed new developments are brought forward to meet local needs in line with national policy requirements. The Local Plan covers the whole of the City of York area.

The Local Plan will be submitted to the Secretary of State for formal examination and is now published for public consultation. Any representations received at this stage will be forwarded to the Secretary of State as part of the examination into the Local Plan.
