

NOTICE OF ELECTION

ELECTION OF A PARISH COUNCILLOR FOR THE PARISH OF MURTON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

An election is to be held for **SIX** Parish Councillors for the Parish of Murton.

Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the Customer Meeting Room B, West Offices, Station Rise, York between the hours of 10am and 4pm on any day after the date of this notice (except Saturday 20 May 2023 and Sunday 21 May 2023), but not later than 4pm on Thursday 25 May 2023.

Nomination papers may be obtained from the Returning Officer on the dates and times aforesaid at the Customer Meeting Room B, West Offices, Station Rise, York and who will, at the request of any elector for the area, prepare a nomination paper for signature.

If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 22 June 2023**.

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by midnight on 6 June 2023. The last day for applications to request a postal vote or re-direction of a postal vote or cancel an existing postal vote or proxy appointment is 5pm on Wednesday 7 June 2023. The last day for new applications to vote by proxy is 5pm on Wednesday 14 June 2023. The deadline for applications to apply for a Voter Authority Certificate is 5pm on Wednesday 14 June 2023. All applications must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Offices, Station Rise, York YO1 6GA by the deadline listed.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or work/service must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Offices, Station Rise, York YO1 6GA by 5pm on Thursday 22 June 2023. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 14 June 2023. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station after 5pm on Wednesday 14 June 2023.
