Notice is hereby given that City of York Council, in exercise of powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Schedule 9 of the Act, proposes to make an Order which will have the effect of:

- 1) Introducing a restriction on vehicles, with the exception of pedal cycles, travelling in:
  - a) Foundry Way, between points 52 metres and 54 metres south west from the projected south western kerbline of Leeman Road;
  - b) Hudson Boulevard, between points 70 metres and 72 metres north east from the projected north eastern kerbline of Cinder Street;
  - c) Hudson Boulevard, between points 40 metres and 42 metres west from the projected western kerbline of Cinder Street.
- 2) Introducing a 24 hour with-flow Local Bus Lanes for the passage of Local Buses, Hackney Carriages, Private Hire Vehicles, solo Motor Cycles and Pedal Cycles in Cinder Street, on its northern side, between points 48 meters and 452 meters east from its junction with Park Street.

City of York Council, in furtherance of their policy of minimising obstruction and congestion and improving road safety and local amenities whilst at the same time balancing residential and commercial considerations, are satisfied that it is desirable to amend the local traffic regulations to the extent set out in the 'Notice of Proposals' (Notice):

- 1) In paragraph 1 of the Notice to improve pedestrian and cycle safety and convenience with the introduction of measures.
- 2) In paragraph 2 of the Notice to prioritise the passage of existing local bus timetabled services, albeit prioritised, traffic flow will be maintained thereby minimising obstruction/congestion and improving safety. The anticipated increase in public transport usage along the route will be instrumental in containing general traffic flow along the route.
